

Pre-Pharmacy Course Requirements

The pharmacy prerequisites **can be completed in two years of undergraduate study** and must be completed before starting the PharmD program. Many applicants start and complete the PharmCAS application for admittance to pharmacy school while still completing the pharmacy prerequisites. All pharmacy prerequisites must be completed with a C- or better grade. Advanced Placement (AP) or Dual Credit courses taken in high school may be used to fulfill pharmacy prerequisites.
